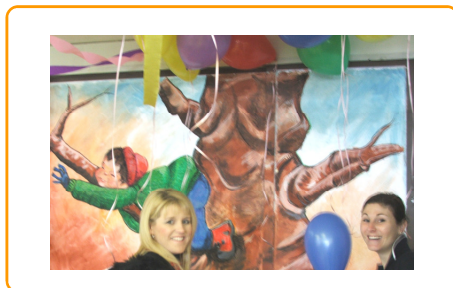
What's Happening
